REPORT

INTRODUCTION:

Green audit is all about corporate responsibility. It uncovers the truth about statements made by governments and institutions with regard to the effects of environmental pollution. The aim of green audit is to review the measures taken by the institution to combat pollution.

Green audit is defined as “an official examination of the effects a institution has on the environment.” It is also widely known as Environmental Audit. Green Audit can be better understood as: Compliance of Environmental Laws, Audit of Environment Cost and Environment Impact Assessment, and Carbon Credit at G.D.C. Rajouri, the management believes that saving ‘Mother Earth’ is an integral part of education and believes that the carbon footprint left by the college is to be reduced by sustainable steps and an environment friendly model of administration.

OBJECTIVES:

The Green Audit process focused on a few points to be closely focused on which are as follows

1. to provide a healthy environment in campus
2. To enhance awareness towards environmental guidelines and responsibilities.
3. To identify cost saving methods through minimizing and effectively managing waste.

GREEN AUDIT PROCESS

Green Audit process at GDC Rajouri was conducted in the three phases

- Pre-audit activity
- Audit
- Action plans and recommendations

A) PRE-AUDIT ACTIVITY

The Science Club, Department of Botany, Eco-Club, NCC, NSS Unit and other departments of the College strives to bring in quality in its initiative to connect to Mother Nature. In its persuasion towards its goal, the core committee members conducted several brain-storming sessions, meeting various organizations involved in auditing. The club also conducted various meetings at different levels within college.

The team conducted a few briefing sessions on the importance and need of the green audit process and ways it was carried out with Dr. Shamim Ahmed Azad Principal of the College campus. Subsequently, Prof. Assadullah Khan, the IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) Co-ordinator conducted a few meetings with the core committee members of Green Audit, who steered the working of this audit process.

Later, the core committee for Green Audit had several rounds of meeting with various Green audit firms. The sessions were comprised of set of awareness programs. Movies-screening and poster making displays for students.

Later, an in-house combing activity to figure out a full timer support was conducted, during which the team found an in-house support from Dr. Anwer Shah who helped the team conduct the Audit Process in smooth manner.

B) GREEN AUDIT PROCESS/OUTCOMES

In line with the guidance and support provided, the Green Audit Process was conducted by the dedicated team of Green Audit Committee members. The Step and outcomes of the Audit are mentioned below:

- g) **Rainwater harvesting:** The college saves a substantial amount of water through rain water Harvesting and water saved is used to water the flora in the campus.
- h) **Vertical Gardening:** It helps in overcoming space constraints and carbon footprints Department of Botany, Science Club and Eco-Club took an initiative to take sustainable steps towards conserving the environment. The event witnessed a gardening competition: vertical garden was set to spread the following message-“the earth loves you, love it back”
- i) **Outreach programs:** In order to create awareness on cleanliness, pollution minimization and recycling- the college has tied up with many private and semi-private organizations to conduct awareness drives and outreach programs. The activities in turn sensitize the students to problems affecting the society and planet as whole.
- j) **Responsible management of hazardous waste:** Any hazardous waste materials that are produced in the campus are disposed of, in a safe and responsible manner. The cleaning staffs are kept well-informed about the disposal process. Step taken in this regard helps the institution responds to the environmental needs effectively.

Following actions were taken based on the suggestion given.





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

OVERVIEW OF THE INSTITUTE

Government Degree College Rajouri is located at a small beautiful plateau at village Kheora, three and half kilometers to the north of the City of Kings, Rajouri town. The College campus gives a picturesque look in the backdrop of snow capped Pir-Panjal Mountains of the Middle Himalayas in the far North. A monument, Dhani Dhar Fort, of Mian Hathu's times, lies just to the east. And in the west lies the Darhal Tawi a source tributary of Manawar Tawi; while to its south lies the historic town, Rajouri.

The college is situated at 33.25oN latitudes and 69.30oE longitude. It has been constructed at a plateau spreading its grandeur of buildings, lawns and grounds over almost 100 kanals of land, which houses three separate hostels for boys and girls and staff quarters, an administrative block, lecture halls, well equipped laboratories and a multi-purpose Hall.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Nature is a very precious gift for all life forms and rapid population explosion, urbanization, degradation of natural resources, and climate change at local, regional and global level is leading us to global "Environmental poverty". Stabilization of human population, equal sharing of green and sustainable technologies and ecological restoration are crucial elements in achieving sustainable development goals where all living creatures including humans live in harmony with nature and natural resources. Thus, institutes of higher learning plays an important in sharing knowledge among its all stake holders.

As an Institution of higher learning and research Government Degree College Rajouri is an active player in spreading environmental awareness among students in particular and society in general. Environmental sciences being taught as one of the subjects reflects that we create eco-centric thinking among students that will help in the protection of mother earth and will also create a spirit of corporate responsibility among its students in particular and other stake holders in general towards the planet. Protecting environment and its natural resources is a fundamental duty and Government Degree College Rajouri is deeply concerned about Environmental protection, therefore owes its responsibility in handing over safer planet to its future generations.

This report is based on the approaches and interventions done on part of the College to address

the environmental concerns of the College and adjacent areas. The current environmental audit represents the first stage in our efforts to build environmental sustainability on the campus. The audit was conducted by a team of faculty and students. It is indeed the reflection of Government Degree College Rajouri endeavor to inculcate eco-friendly environment within and outside the campus. Therefore, actions taken in favour of environmental protection and sustainable development are proof that we are concerned about shared responsibilities.

This "Environment Audit" report would help everyone to think about preserving resources, shows a willingness to learn their importance, adopt steps to minimize resource use and set an example for others to follow the path of eco-friendly practices to achieve the goal of sustainable development. Effective implementation of environmental auditing helps in minimization of environmental risks at a lower cost.

ENVIRONMENTAL AUDIT AND ITS NEED

Environmental audit is an exercise where compliance of environmental management system in areas like energy consumption, green house gas emissions, waste water, solid waste, land use and biodiversity is being periodically monitored. Periodic evaluation of these components helps us assessing our contribution towards the sustainable development of the college and also the concept of promoting environmental consciousness among its students. In order to have all-round development and onus of environmental stewardship it is imperative that besides, curricular and co-curricular activities students and teachers do take part in the assessment of activities within the domain of college environment. It is also a self-enquiry to know how much judicious utilization of natural resources are made within the college campus. Besides, the participation of students in the audit is the reflection that not only college produces abled graduates but environmentally conscious citizens for our better and safe future. On this background, it becomes indispensable to adopt the system of the "Zero Tolerance" for environmental degradation. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore Karnataka (NAAC) has made it mandatory that all Higher Educational Institutions should submit an annual Green Audit Report for accreditation/re-accreditation of higher educational institutions.

OBJECTIVES OF ENVIRONMENTAL AUDIT

Concern about environmental degradation and realization of values of environment are logical consequences of scholarly research, teaching and learning process. In its pursuit for improving environmental quality and to maintain a pristine environment for the future generations of students, Government Degree College Rajouri has made a self-inquiry on environmental quality of the campus with the following objectives to achieve:

- 1) Environmental education through systematic environmental management approach
- 2) Improving environmental standards
- 3) Sustainable use of natural resource in the campus.
- 4) Eco Friendly practices in campus for reduction in resource use.
- 5) Curriculum enrichment through practical experience.
- 6) Development of ownership, personal and social responsibility for the college campus and its environment
- 7) Enhancement of college profile
- 8) Inculcation of environmental ethic and value systems in young minds
- 9) Establishing a baseline of existing environmental conditions with focus on natural and physical environment.
- 10) Understanding the current practices of sustainability with regard to the use of water and energy, generation of wastes, purchase of goods, transportation etc.
- 11) Awareness generation among students concerning real issues of environment and its sustainability.
- 12) Promotion of environmental awareness through participatory auditing process.
- 13) To create a baseline data of good practices and provide strategies and action plans towards improving environmental quality for a better future.

ENERGY AUDIT

Energy conservation is a growing concern all over the world and same is true for India. Energy production is not in pace with consumption. Therefore energy audit is a systematic tool for any

institution to know its energy consumption and to switch over to alternate energy sources where ever possible. Energy audit identifies areas in the institution where energy is being unnecessarily consumed and also identifies areas where it can be saved. The energy is utilized in the Campus for lighting, room heating and cooling, running of laboratory instruments, appliances and ground water pumping.

The data indicates that the College mostly use hydropower electricity supplied by the State Government. The college has installed one diesel generator used for meeting requirement during electricity curtailment. It is an acoustic enclosure generator, CPCB approved having long chimney, soundproof and installed on concrete bed of suitable height.

TRANSPORT AUDIT

Government Degree College Rajouri provides transport facility to Students. So Far College owns one bus which is being used for pick and drop services from college campus to Saaj, field surveys and other NSS and NCC activities. College staff members use personal vehicles and their approximate number goes to 60. Students use public transport, indicating lesser carbon foot print of the student community.

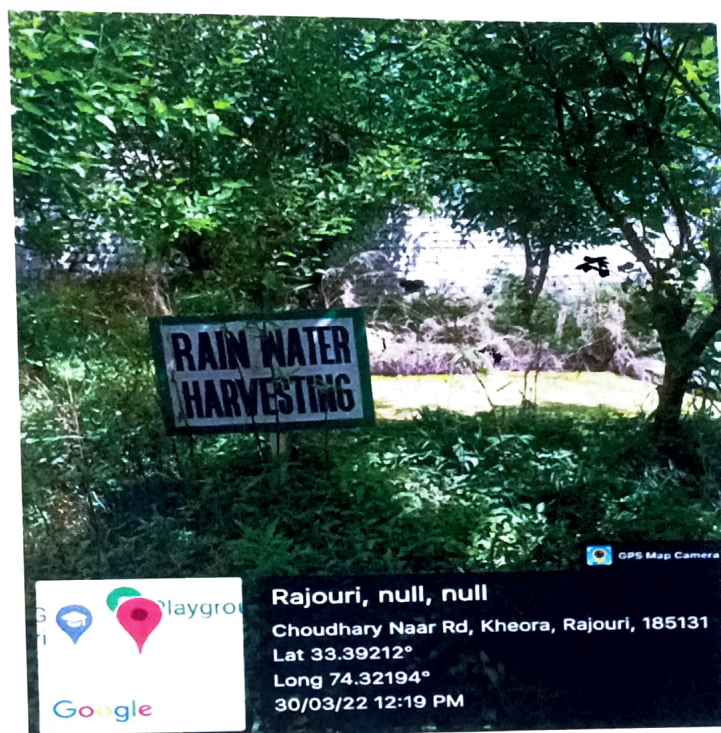
WATER AUDIT

Water audit is conducted periodically in GDC Rajouri just to ensure that water is being used judiciously. The college has many water storage tanks in different blocks.

These tanks are connected to a centrally located underground well with unlimited water supply capacity. The well provides fresh underground water to all the buildings of the college. The well is fitted with the one horse electric motor and water is being lifted every alternate day from the well and is being supplied to different blocks of the college. This water is being used as drinking water also by students, teaching and non-teaching staff. Water distribution system is regularly being monitored for any possible water leakage just to ensure water is not being wasted unnecessarily.

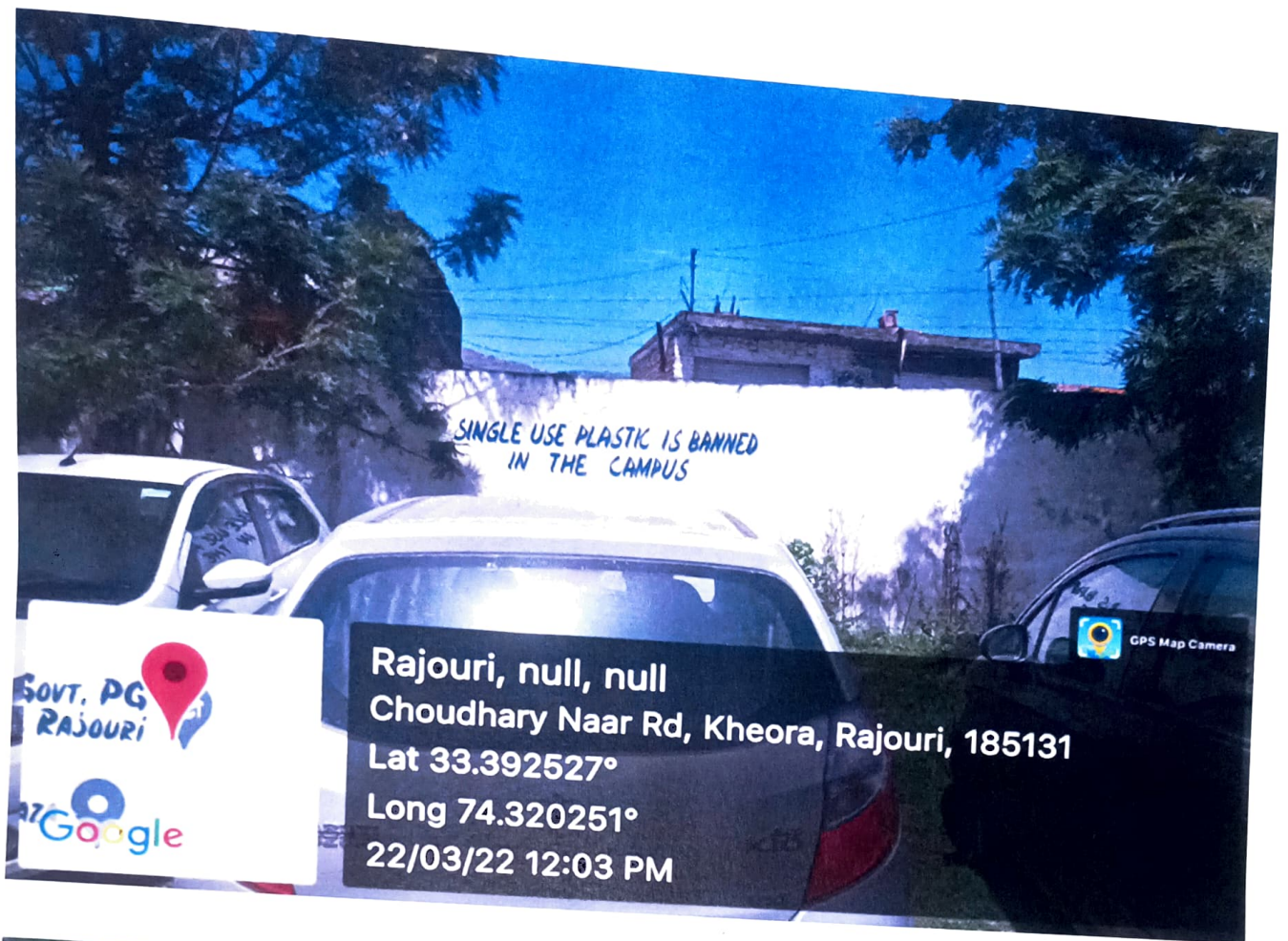

SOLID WASTE AUDIT

Government Degree college Rajouri has efficient mechanism of solid waste management. Both bio degradable and non- biodegradable waste is released from the campus. Separate collection bins are installed for collection of wastes. Non -biodegradable waste is segregated at the source and earlier recyclable waste like plastic bottles, tins, cardboards, wires etc were given to local vendor for recycling, The College has its own collection facility that collects the solid wastes daily from different Departments. This helps in maintaining the cleanliness by providing an efficient safe and regulated management of solid wastes in the Campus. However, e- waste like unused computers, batteries, cables, etc are stored and auctioned from time to time. Eco-club organizes various activities in college to aware the students and faculty members for the safe disposal of solid waste. Moreover bins are kept and waste collected is handed over to municipal for its disposal.



PLANTATION AUDIT

The college has separate committee for green landscaping and beautification who looks after the maintenance of gardens and ensures that every year more and more plantation drives are to be taken. So far every year especially on the world Environment day comprehensive plantation drive are taken every year in the college. This also helps in carbon sequestration. An effort of our college to contribute in the reduction of global warming. The college has also maintained botanical garden where ex-situ conservation of different Himalayan medicinal herbs is done. Garden in front of biosciences department is also maintained with rich varieties of plants



BEST PRACTICES FOR GREEN INITIATIVES

All the lower hierarchy staff is well included in environmental awareness programmes and campaigns

- *Biodiversity Conservation* – Flora and fauna conservation programs and multiple environment awareness campaigns are organized by the College.
- *Tree Plantation Drives* – Tree Plantation Drives are organized regularly. Guests visiting the college on the Annual Day or other events are honoured by way of their contribution towards the Drive.
- *Ground Water Recharge* - 1 unit of Rain Water Harvesting System.
- *E-Waste Management* - Old computers and other e-waste are managed through CPCB authorized recyclers.
- *Solid Waste Management* – Waste segregation and management is carried out by third-party vendor and waste minimization practices (like avoiding / minimizing food waste, ban on plastic crockery, etc.) are adopted.
- *Water Conservation* – Regular checkup for leakage is monitored.







RECOMMENDATIONS

- Provide sanitary waste disposal facility by following the CPCB guidelines for the management of sanitary waste - As per Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016. An incinerator machines should be installed at the campus for sanitary waste disposal
- Water balancing Audit should be conducted

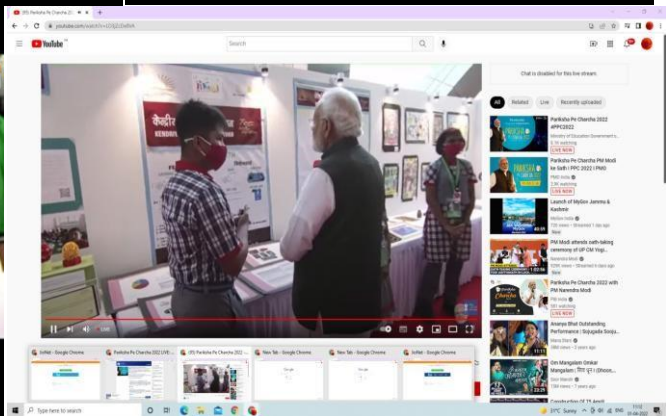
